For 2013 the category of forcible sexual offenses includes the felonies of rape and forcible sodomy as well as misdemeanors such as sexual abuse and sexual misconduct. Non-forcible offenses include statutory rape, incest, and certain cases of misconduct. Beginning in 2014 forcible sex offenses included rape and fondling and non-forcible sex offenses include statutory rape and incest as defined in the annual security report.

\*These incidents/arrests occurred on property adjacent to campus, and the college is required to display these crime statistics. The subjects involved in these cases had no affiliation to Buffalo State College.

\*\*Beginning in 2014, institutions must include all reports of Clery Act crimes that occurred on or within their Clery geography, including those determined to be "unfounded." If a reported crime is investigated by law enforcement authorities and found to be false or baseless, the crime is "unfounded." Only sworn or commissioned law enforcement personnel may unfound a crime.

### The following are the hate crime incidents reported on campus in 2015:

- Case number 15-701682 On 2/19/15 an intimidation/harassment was reported on campus, characterized by a disability bias. There were no injuries.
- Case number 15-702428 On 3/14/15 an intimidation/harassment was reported in a residence hall, characterized by a gender bias. There were no injuries.
- Case number 15-703590 On 4/18/15 an intimidation/harassment was reported on campus, characterized by a race bias. There were no injuries.
- Case number 15-708775 On 10/12/15 a criminal mischief/vandalism was reported on campus, characterized by a religion bias. There were no injuries. Damaged property valued at \$25.

### The following are the hate crime incidents reported on campus in 2014:

- Case number 14-703450 On 3/19/14 an intimidation/harassment was reported on campus, characterized by a sex orientation bias. There were no injuries.
- Case number 14-705051 On 4/29/14 a criminal/mischief/vandalism was reported on campus, characterized by a religion bias. There were no injuries. Damaged property valued at \$50.

### The following are the hate crime incidents reported on campus in 2013:

- Case number 13-705413 On 5/14/13 an intimidation/harassment was reported on campus, characterized by a sex orientation bias. There were no injuries.
- Case number 13-709575 On 8/30/13 an intimidation/harassment was reported in a residence hall, characterized by a sex orientation bias. There were no injuries.
- Case number 13-713077 On 11/7/13 an intimidation/harassment was reported on campus, characterized by a race bias. There were no injuries.
- Case number 13-713283 On 11/12/13 a criminal mischief/vandalism was reported on campus, characterized by a gender bias. There were no injuries.
